SEX OFFENDER RELEASE - COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

**October 7, 2020** - The Wisconsin Department of Corrections has informed the Beloit Police Department that Kenneth R. Cairns, 60, will reside at 259 W. Grand Avenue Apt. 6 in Beloit starting October 2, 2020. Cairns was recently discharged from his §980.08(04)(em) commitment as a violent sex offender. His convictions include multiple second-degree sexual assaults and second-degree sexual assault of a child.

The purpose of this notification is to ensure safe neighborhoods by informing the public when a sex offender who qualifies for a Special Bulletin Notification is released into the Beloit community. On June 1, 1997, Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 (Act 440), the Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Law, took effect to enhance public safety and protection.

Cairns is required to remain on the sex offender registry for life and is subject to lifetime GPS monitoring. He is not subject to any other requirements.
