Defense and Arrest Tactics (DAAT) Instructors received an Excellence in Training award for developing a more realistic training for patrol officers to reinforce skills, knowledge, and abilities of officers to make difficult decisions under stressful situations, while utilizing the least amount of force necessary. DAAT instructors also developed training to assist new officers in maintaining good situational awareness and officer presence. They work with all new officers to make sure they are current on the Department's Use of Force policies and become certified to carry a Taser.
