BELOIT/JANESVILLE EXPRESS

Beloit Transit and the Janesville Transit System jointly operate service between the two cities year round Monday through Friday, except holidays.

The route runs between the Beloit Transit Transfer Facility, through the Janesville Downtown Transfer Center, and extends north to the Rock County Complex on Highway 14 in Janesville.

Stops are made at all locations along the route, as well as at the Rock County Job Center, UW-Rock County, Blackhawk Technical College, Rock Valley Community Programs, Rock County institutions, Kandu Industries (select trips), Arrow Park and Riverfront, Inc. The route also connects with both Beloit Transit and Janesville Transit local routes.

How to transfer from the Beloit/Janesville Express: When you board the BJE bus and pay a regular cash fare or use a BJE punch pass (without a transfer from a Beloit City Route bus), you may request a free transfer, which will allow you to continue your ride on a connecting Beloit City Route bus.

CHOOSE YOUR WAY TO PAY

There are several options to choose from when paying your fare. You can save money by buying tokens or passes before taking your trip. Tokens and passes may be purchased at the outlets described in this guide. For one fare you will get one ride plus a transfer, if necessary.

BOARDING THE BUS

Please stand next to the bus stop sign (close enough to touch it). Persons standing on a sidewalk or far away from the bus stop may be missed. Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before you attempt to board and stay back from the doors until they fully open.

Board the bus quickly, have the **Exact Fare** ready. Do not use foreign coins. **The driver can not make change.**

Front seats are reserved for senior citizens and disabled passengers. If all the seats are taken, please move towards the rear of the bus and hold onto a handrail.

EXITING THE BUS

Signal the driver to stop within one block of your stop. Do not ask the driver to stop anywhere other than a designated stop. To signal, push the chime strip located between the windows.

Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before leaving your seat.

Watch your step as you leave the bus. Wait for the bus to clear the area before crossing the street.

Never cross in front of the bus!

HOW TO TRANSFER BUSES

If you need to use more than one bus on your trip, you will need to ask your driver for a transfer when you first get on the bus. Transfers are free and must be requested when the fare is paid. Be sure to let the driver know which route you'll be transferring to, so he or she can help ensure that you will make your connection. Limit one transfer per passenger.

Transfers are good only for the time shown. They cannot be used to return on the same route and must be handed to the driver when the transfer is made.

BUS RULES

Remember that your driver is in charge, and may ask any rider who behaves in an unruly manner or does not observe these rules to leave the bus. If a passenger refuses to obey the driver, the police will be called.

Video and audio recording systems are in use at the Transfer Center and on BTS buses. Images and audio recorded by these systems may be used to identify and prosecute offenders.

Use common courtesy on the bus and while waiting at the stops. Also, always remember to offer your seat to anyone who, because of age or physical condition, is less able to stand than you are.

HERE ARE SOME OTHER RULES OF THE BUS:

- Smoking is not allowed on buses or passenger shelters.
- Food or beverages are not allowed.
- Please don't leave trash on the seat or the floor.
- Don't put your head or hand out of the window, or throw anything out of the window.
- Don't bring more packages on the bus than you can carry yourself as you board. The driver will not be able to help you get your bags on board, and when the bus is crowded you will need to hold your packages on your lap to make room for other passengers.
- Large batteries, gasoline cans and oxygen tanks other than small tanks meant for personal use, are not allowed on board.
- Weapons of any kind are prohibited.
- Only service animals for disabled are permitted.
- Loud or vulgar language, and pushing or rough housing is never allowed. Violators will be asked to leave the bus.
- You may occupy only one seat, and may not put your feet on walls or seats.
- Please do not play electronic devices without headphones.
- Keep carts and large packages out of the aisle.
- **Children are not allowed to stay in a stroller on the bus.** Remove children from strollers while on board and fold strollers up before boarding the bus.
- Avoid long conversations with the driver.
- Shirt and shoes are required. Ice/roller skates are not allowed.

SCHOOL DAY TRIPPER ROUTES

Beloit Transit Day Tripper Routes provide service to select area schools. Tripper Routes operate on school days only but are open to the public.

HOW TO CONDUCT A CITY ROUTE TRANSFER WITH A BJE PUNCH PASS

When you ride a Beloit City Route, your BJE Punch Pass is punched by the City Route bus driver and a transfer is issued. When boarding the BJE bus, show the pass and give the transfer to the driver. You may not receive another transfer.

PARATRANSIT SERVICE

Disabled persons who cannot get to a bus stop from their home, from the bus stop to their destination or require more assistance in using transit than can be given by a driver (wheel chair ramps and lifts, minor boarding and offloading) may qualify for paratransit service.

We contract with Rock County Specialized Transit to provide complementary paratransit services. This "Dial-A-Ride" service operates on an advanced reservation basis only, and reservations must be made the day before transportation is needed. It is available during the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The basic cash fare for paratransit service is \$3.50 (\$7.00 between Beloit and Janesville).

In order to use paratransit service you must apply to Beloit Transit System to determine eligibility. Call us at (608) 364-2870 for more details on this service or to obtain an application. To obtain paratransit application forms online go to www.beloittransit.com.

Once a determination of eligibility has been made, reservations for transportation can be made by contacting Rock County Specialized Transit at (608) 757-5054. TDD users can call (608) 757-5226.


SERVICE DAYS & TIMES
