

NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR EXTERNAL FUNDING

PURPOSE OF GRANT:

The project will reconstruct the 400 block of East Grand Avenue. Anticipated improvements may include new curb and gutter, sidewalk upgrades, possible utility upgrades, roadway reconstruction and striping. During the design process, the potential for alternative methods of stormwater management, streetscape upgrades, and new striping will be determined. The project is currently in the City's 6-year plan and Capital Improvement Program.

NAME OF GRANT: Multimodal Local Supplement (MLS) Grant

AMOUNT OF PROPOSED GRANT: \$577,380

LOCAL MATCH REQUIREMENTS: \$57,738 (10%)

PURPOSE OF GRANT:

The project limits are Park Avenue between Broad Street and Bayliss Avenue. The planned improvements include concrete slab replacement, filling sidewalk gaps, updates to sidewalk ramps for ADA compliance, and new on-street striping for bike accommodations. The project will complete a north/south multi-modal corridor within the urbanized area which will allow users to travel within Beloit to the Town of Beloit and the City of South Beloit in Illinois. These corridor improvements were included in the 2017 Pedestrian and Bicycle Plan Update. This project will enhance multi-modal connectivity in the Stateline.
